Hello all! Jesse Alsbach, son of Neal and Darcey Alsbach, here. First newsletter! It's an exciting step in my new role as a missionary with NAIM! For many years I have watched from afar and respected the amazing men and women that work in North America Indigenous Ministries. I consider it an honour and a privilege that the Lord has brought me here.

As many of you know, I was diagnosed with MS two years back. I was unable to work anymore as a paramedic and wondered where the Lord wanted me. I have always loved NAIM and the mission work that they did and so applied for the role of recruiter with NAIM. After a several-month application process, they welcomed me with open arms and immediately got me working. **"The Lord gives, and the Lord takes away. Blessed be the name of the Lord" (Job 1:21)** has always been a favourite verse of mine. The ability to continue to praise God even in the worst of times has always made Job an amazing example of godly living that I hope to emulate.

In recruitment, I have the opportunity to go to multiple locations and represent NAIM at conventions and schools. My father and I recently went down to Moody Bible Institute in Chicago for their missions





conference. I recently also went to the ICOM event in Richmond, Virginia. The experiences, while new to me, were wonderful, seeing so many students and faculty be as excited as I was about the mission field. I have loved the mission field for so many years and have grown up surrounded by it. I consider myself extremely blessed to be in the position I am today.

In order to continue this ministry, I do need a prayer and financial support team. I currently am at the

support level of \$250 a month. NAIM is requiring me to raise a minimum of \$2000 a month. As you can imagine, recruitment also takes a lot of driving, and as my MS limits me from always being able to drive a standard vehicle, I am in the process of also looking for a newer, reliable vehicle.
