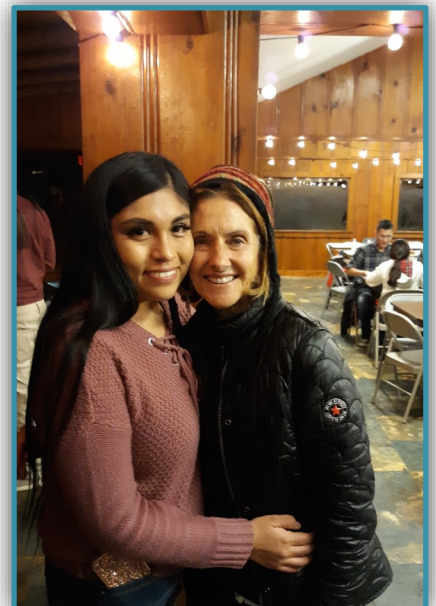

Interest in Christianity among the students is obviously a growing awareness of who Jesus was and is today. Tim told the story of an ex-gang member who has become a key figure in the lives of so many on the Baja. He kicked some awful addictions and became a rehab director and pastor. The students listened intently and when we asked for the ones interested in our annual trip to Mexico to sign-up we realized we had a problem - **TOO MANY SIGNED UP!** So now we have a prayer request that those that are supposed to come on this trip, starting March 12th, would be in the van.
