Eight inches of snow on Oct 11 is the norm here in this fine state. Though it snowed into the evening, the lighting of the teepees went on as scheduled. There were hundreds of people there. Several spoke at what has now become the celebration of Indian Heritage Day.

A few days later, on Saturday the 16, with summer like weather, MSU celebrated the opening of the Native American Hall, a 22 million dollar building that displays incredible Native architecture. Much of this building is dedicated for the use of the growing number of Native students. There are 812 enrolled at MSU this semester. We will be using parts of this building for the Nations ministry.



It's easy to be caught up in the positive things that are happening here in Bozeman. The ministry is up and running with a lot of new students. We move among these students and the faculty of the Native community with considerable favor, truly a work of God. Abundant time is spent with the Native students. We really love what we are doing. But it is not idyllic. There is another part of the reality.



I was up in the middle of the night wrestling with the deep confusion and complexities the students face.

Regrettably, they are being marinated in an environment of post-modern confusion.

G.K. Chesterton's, "When a man stops believing in God, he doesn't believe in nothing, he believes in anything."


