Dear Friend,

Since the Tribal Ministry Conference in April, a substantial amount of ministry effort has been in serving practical needs of members of Sacred Path Fellowship. There are a variety of ongoing transportation, financial, relational, health, and legal issues that some of our people need help with, along with more focus on spiritual growth and ministry vision.

Please continue to pray with us for greater gospel inroads among culturally traditional Native families and individuals, who for the most part, are disinclined to consider Christianity a viable option to embrace. The concept that Christianity is a “white man’s religion” is quite widespread in Indian Country.

There have been a series of setbacks in our ministry outreach to the Port Madison Reservation, home of the Suquamish people. A knowledgeable member of the tribe told me that there are influential Suquamish people who are opposed to Christianity. We are seeing evidence of that.

We had a booth at the Chief Seattle Days celebration there in mid-August again this year. There were fewer contacts made there this time, but one of our most faithful attendees has offered to open her home for a Bible study. Please be praying for more open hearts and spiritual breakthroughs in Suquamish.

God answered our prayers for good contacts in our booth at the Labor Day Pow Wow sponsored by the Puyallup Tribe. We will be following up with these people.

Also, please pray about the beginnings of a new Native-focused work in the greater Seattle area. By the time this letter goes out, a small core of leaders will have met to strategize on this.

Nancy and I are very grateful for the financial and prayer support for our ministry. Thank you.
