We are in the midst of trying to get her financially set up through different services, and hopefully get her moved into our home so she can save up to go to a YWAM, or a Bible college. It is her desire to chase after God and make Him the

centre of her life. She has had many difficult circumstances involving her community in Maskwacis, and within her personal life. I am continually praying for her to keep leaning and pressing into God. She is so kind and sweet with those around her. She has this quiet strength and resilience that I just see the Lord working in her to keep pushing through. Next weekend we are looking into finding people to talk to at an open house at a Bible College in Camrose that Isaac went to. (Canadian Lutheran Bible Institute) It has been a gift to have a deeper understanding and relationship with her. I ask that our supporters reading this would pray for her in God providing for her to be financially stable to save/build her life, that she would be spiritually protected, and that God would bless her endeavours in making a life for herself. Many young adults we work with have so many different challenges that work against them creating a sustainable lifestyle.

We also had the opportunity to go through with having more education and awareness on FASD back in October. The lady and her son that speak on this are from Maskwacis. They were wonderful to meet with and learn more in depth about this disability. Life 360 continues to be growing every week. We see so many youth come and be engaged with learning more about God, and fellowship. Girls group is in full swing, and I have been helping more with food, and craft needs, as well as some rides that the youth need in order to come.





During this period of the year, if you are led to increase your giving monthly this would help with the needs for gas, food, and meeting expenses with young adults and the youth groups we help out with. Our shortfall for this next year in 2024 is \$1600/mo. We greatly appreciate your efforts in helping meet the ministry and spiritual needs of our young people in Maskwacis.
